

On the next page of this document there is a table with words and short sentences (you can add some more, depending on the number of students). Cut the squares, mix the leaves and distribute them to the students. They then have the task of moving around the class and finding a classmate who has the same word/sentence translated from a foreign language into Czech or vice versa. When they find each other, they sit together on the bench. Pair checking and discussion follow: what foreign language is the word/sentence from? (the languages are listed on the third page of this document).

In the next part of the lesson, you can talk about which language groups the given languages come from, show examples of them (for example on YouTube), etc.
